The Facilities Coordinator is an employee of the Free Congregation with the following responsibilities.

- Serve as the contact person for all rental inquiries.
 - Meet with the rental requestor(s) at the Hall for a tour, discussion of the rental contract, and to answer questions.
 - Complete the contract with renters, take their deposits, and complete any other contractual items.
- Be a positive and welcoming presence for the use of FCSC facilities (Park Hall and its grounds, and the Andrew Roll meeting hall and grounds) by the community and Free Congregation of Sauk County members.
- Promote the use of FCSC facilities by the community whenever possible through newspaper articles, advertisements, Facebook and other social media, attendance at Chamber of Commerce and service club meetings, etc.
- Attend scheduled FCSC Board meetings and provide, in a timely fashion, a written Facilities Coordinator's report monthly.
- Part-time, \$18.50 per hour. Hours vary with scheduled events.
